Alberta Theatre Projects launches fundraising initiative for the Darcy Evans Senior Management Apprenticeship

CALGARY, Sept. 29, 2021 – Alberta Theatre Projects is kicking off a fundraising campaign to support the newly announced Darcy Evans Senior Management Apprenticeship, a three-month mentorship program for emerging professionals to gain executive experience in the theatre industry. To ensure the apprenticeship is fully sustainable, Alberta Theatre Projects is targeting to raise \$72,000 by October 31 to take advantage of donor matching programs.

Evans was paramount to ensuring the long-term sustainability of Alberta Theatre Projects and was dedicated to supporting the next generation of artists.

"I am so thrilled that this Legacy Fund has enabled Darcy's vision, spirit and tireless energy to live on, as it helps create opportunities for growth among a new generation of arts leaders in Calgary. I can think of no more fitting and meaningful way to honour Darcy's memory."

Working directly with Alberta Theatre Projects' senior management team, the apprentice will contribute to key strategic decisions within the organization, equipping them for the next step in their career.
