In Wonderland to be a true holiday spectacle, featuring three artists portraying all the familiar characters, supported by theatre magic

CALGARY, November 16, 2021 - This holiday season, Alberta Theatre Projects invites families back to their playhouse with the reimagining of a nostalgic classic. *In Wonderland*, a World Premiere, is based on Lewis Carroll's beloved novels, *Alice's Adventures In Wonderland* and *Through the Looking Glass*.

The commissioned script was written by Calgary-based actor Anna Cummer, and collaboratively developed and workshopped in-house. Cummer was first approached by the show's Director, Haysam Kadri, in June 2021. Kadri invited her to adapt a new holiday show based on a familiar classic of her choice. The catch - could it be done with only three actors?

During the first lockdown of the pandemic, Cummer read *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* with her children. Carroll's fantastical, whimsical world was a welcomed escape for them. It felt like a perfect fit for ATP's holiday show. The small cast size made it a golden opportunity to reframe the familiar classic. Cummer was further inspired by Vaudevillian theatre, and presented her vision of the story as a family-centric variety show with everything from clown acts to musical numbers, complete with slap-stick and poetry. Each scene would become a fast-paced vignette tied together by the aesthetics and performance style of Vaudeville, sure to entertain and delight both children and adults.

"We follow a young girl navigating the topsy-turvy world of social interactions and skirting the edges of adulthood," said Cummer. With Kadri's encouragement, Cummer departed slightly from the source material to write an Alice with more agency which helped focus the coming-of-age story. It made the tale more timeless and relevant.

"Carroll's novels have not faded in the slightest by time," said director Haysam Kadri. "Alice's adventures will continue to intrigue us for countless years to come, and the story fittingly taps into the disorienting feelings of pandemic living: the bizarre dreams, the confusion around time, appetite for escape, and perpetual anxiety. There's no better parallel in time to tell this story."

Theatre magic will be fully realized onstage in the Martha Cohen Theatre through projections, extraordinary scenic elements, lighting illusions and shadows, costumes and puppetry, which all play a vital role in the storytelling. Hanne Loosen, well-known to ATP audiences for her spectacular designs in 2019's holiday presentation, *Lion, Witch and the Wardrobe*, has created a dazzling world of imagination, absurdity and abstraction, which will transfix audiences throughout this wild, and sometimes outrageous, world of Wonderland.

Alberta Theatre Projects is proud to share that *In Wonderland* will be going on tour to Richmond, BC, in April 2022, presented by Gateway Theatre. The original cast and production team is planned to be involved with this production.
